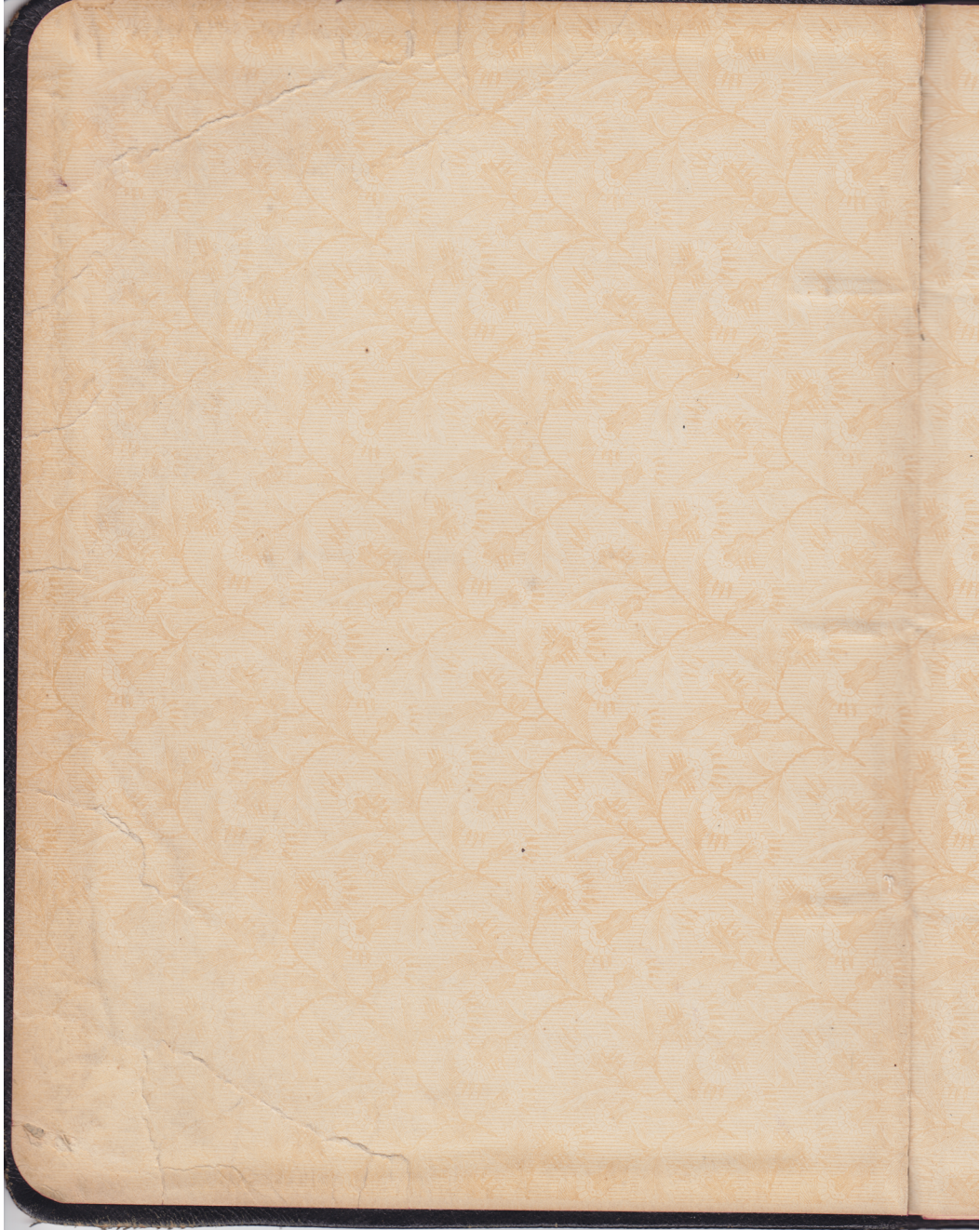

Bradleys.

“The earliest mention in England of the name Bradley, thus far known, is in the year A. D. 1183, at the feast of St. Cuthbert, in Lent. In A. D. 1437, there is mention made of Bradleys of Bradley. In the will of Ralph Smith, which was proved March 23, 1472, he mentions a farm had of Bradley. Again in 1475, the will of Sir John Pitkington, Knight of Yorkshire, bequeaths to his brother Charles a place named Bradley. The name seems to have been applied to places in England, as well as to persons. History shows John Bradley was Bishop of Shaftsbury in 1539. In 1578 Alexander Bradley is mentioned in the jurisdiction of Durham, and about the same year Cuthbertus Bradley was curate of Barnarde Castle.

Thomas Bradley was Doctor of Divinity and Chaplain to King Charles the First. His son Savile was Fellow of Magdalen College in Oxford. About this time the persecution in England led many to emigrate to America. Among the original list of emigrants, or religious exiles, a number of Bradleys are mentioned as having embarked

for America. These lists may not be perfect, as there are still many unpublished documents, which, when brought before the public may help to mend the broken links in many family histories. There are several distinct branches of the Bradley family in the United States, the founders of which came from England, and undoubtedly were descendants from a common ancestor, as the same names are so often repeated. History of the Bradley family, by Samuel Bradley Doggett, tells us the "Haverhill" branch was founded by Daniel Bradley, who was born in 1615 in England, and came to this country in the ship "Elizabeth" from London in 1635. He married, May 21, 1662, Mary, daughter of John William of Haverhill, where he resided. He was killed by the Indians August 13, 1689. He had seven children, two of whom were killed by the Indians March 15, 1697. There was also a Peter Bradley, a mariner.

Francis Bradley was the founder of the "Fairfield" branch. He married Ruth, daughter of John Barlow. He died in 1689, leaving six children.

There is the "North Haven" branch, which was founded by Isaac V. Bradley, whose descendants are numerous and wide-spread.

There resided in the market town of Bingley, of Yorkshire, England, a family by the name of Bradley. The Christian name or occupation not known. History tells us that the head of this Bradley family was married twice. By his first wife he had one son named William.

By his second wife he had five children. William, it is said, was a staunch dissenter, and an officer in Cromwell's army. He emigrated to America in 1637, and joined the New Haven Colony. Hearing of his father's death a year or two later, he sent for his stepmother and her children. On their arrival in America, he took them under his care and protection until the younger ones arrived to years of approaching maturity. Their names were Ellen, Daniel, Joseph, Nathan and Stephen. The two younger later became residents of Guilford, Conn. for the Guilford court records show that in 1658 Nathan and Stephen both testified in court. Their mother subsequently married and settled in Guilford, Conn., where she died in January, 1683.

Barber's Historical Collection of Connecticut Sketches recites the following, which may be of interest here:

"Mr. Nathan Bradley, who was quite a hunter, was the first white person who discovered the source of the Hammenasset River, which originates in a pond, still called Nathan's pond. Mr. Bradley lived to an advanced age, and it is said he killed several hundred deer while he resided in the town of Madison. In the winter season bears, wolves, and other wild animals would resort to the sea coast in considerable numbers. Mr. Bradley in his old age went to see a friend who resided about a mile northerly from the present meeting house in Madison. On his way he was met by a bear with her cubs. He endeavored to ride around her, but as he

moved the bear moved, when he stopped the bear stopped and presented an undaunted front, and seemed determined to oppose his further progress. Mr. Bradley was obliged to turn back, and being somewhat childish in his old age, shed tears that he who had killed so many of these creatures should be obliged at last to turn his back upon one of them."

What is known as the "Guilford Branch" of the Bradley family originated with Nathan and Stephen Bradley. Both married, had children, and lived to good old age. Their descendants are very numerous, and are scattered far and wide. Stephen Bradley was born in England in 1642; was three or four years of age when his mother with her children landed at New Haven, Conn. There he resided under his half-brother's care twelve years or more. History reports many of his descendants as men of distinction in military service, and other governmental interests.

A letter received of recent date from a friend in New York State, who has in past years become deeply interested in the history of the Bradley families of America, having spent a large amount of time and money in collecting information for preparing a correct and complete history of them from the earliest possible date down to the present time, says: "The descendants of William Bradley, your ancestor, are among the most conspicuous in state and national history;" and he states that he hopes some day to be able to arrange and present them properly.

WILLIAM BRADLEY,

Came from England to New Haven, Conn., July 16, A. D. 1637. Was one of the first settlers of that place. History tells us that he was at the head of the New Haven branch of the Bradley family; that he married Alice Pritchard Feb. 18, 1645. He died in New Haven, Conn., in 1691. Alice, his wife, died at same place Oct. 26, 1718.

Son of Eli, Sr., and Phebe Bradley was born at Lee, Mass., Feb. 25, 1796. He married Lucy Ball, Nov. 28, 1816. Lucy Ball was sister of Amanda Ball, above mentioned as the wife of William's brother Eli. Lucy Ball was born at Lee, Mass., Oct. 17, 1798. She was the eldest, and her sister Amanda third, of a family of eleven children born to Capt. Nathan and Fear Ball of Lee, Mass. NATHAN BALL was born at Lee, Mass., Feb. 23, 1768. Died Oct. 30, 1856. He married Fear Chadwick at Lee, Mass., June 29, 1797. Fear Chadwick was born at Lee, Mass., Oct. 19, 1778. Died Dec. 30, 1855.

William and Lucy Bradley moved from Lee, Mass., to Wellington, Lorain Co., Ohio, in May 1835 with their family of five sons and two daughters. Two sons were born to them in Wellington, Ohio. William Bradley died at Wellington, June 8, 1858, and his wife Lucy died at Grafton, Ohio, March 1, 1872. Both buried in Wellington, Lorain Co., Ohio.
